Personal data processed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• mail</li><li>• entitlement (in case of CLARIN Identity Provider)</li></ul>
Third parties to whom personal data is disclosed	No third parties will gain access to the transmitted End User Attributes at any time.
How to access, rectify and delete the personal data	End User Attributes are not stored or logged by BAS after the completion of the data download or the usage of BAS webservice. To rectify the data released by your Home Organisation, contact your Home Organisation's IT helpdesk.
Data retention	Your data is not permanently stored and deleted as soon as the request is finished, compare “How to access, rectify and delete personal data”.
