Terms of Usage of BAS Resources

1. Copies of BAS resources (only latest versions) can be obtained via the BAS. To use a BAS resource a user license has to be purchased by the user. This is also true for cost-free BAS resources; in this case the download of the resource implies the purchase of a BAS user license.
2. The user license authorises the user to exploit the resource for scientific and/or commercial purposes (depending on the type of license). The user license also grants the user the right to obtain additional copies and/or published updates for that resource from the BAS (distribution fees may apply).
3. The transfer of the resource and parts of it to third parties is prohibited. The same applies to modified versions, versions with lower quality or different formats that can be used to replicate the original resource.
4. All copyrights stay with the BAS or with the copyright holder of the resource as stated in the documentation of the resource.
5. The user agrees to protect the privacy of the recorded speakers of the resource and to avoid any non-ethical usage of the signal or meta data.
6. Disclaimer: the use of the speech resources and their metadata is at own risk. All data are provided on an "as is" basis. The BAS expressively disclaims all warranties of any kind. Limitation of liability: the BAS will not be liable for any damages resulting from the use of the speech resources and their metadata.
7. By purchasing the speech corpus and the associated user license the user agrees to all the terms as stated above.
