


Western Arrernte (w. of Alice Springs, N.T., central Australia) laminal dental /t/

Broad contact all along inside surface of upper teeth and beyond. Photographs courtesy of Victoria B. Anderson




W. Arrernte laminal post-alveolar /t/

Broad contact well behind the upper teeth in the midline (partially on teeth in the region of the molars)



W. Arrernte apical alveolar /t/

Narrow contact just behind the upper teeth in the midline (again, partially on teeth in the region of the molars)



W. Arrernte apical post-alveolar /t/ ('retroflex')

Relatively narrow contact well behind the upper teeth in the midline. Some smearing of contact pattern probably indicates movement of the point of contact during the closure
